

NorthWestern Energy

This morning we had the fabulous Debbie Singer who has been with Northwestern Energy for 40 years!

Below, is the chart Debbie used to show where NorthWestern Energy gets their supply.



In order to better manage utilities Northwestern Energy is joining Western Energy Imbalance Market (EIM), a real-time energy market using state of the art software to analyze regional power grid needs and make available low cost generation to meet energy needs every five minutes.

It will be easier to integrate variable renewable output with 24/7 resources including hydro, coal and natural gas generation.

The goal is cost savings, more efficient use renewables, improved grid reliability and using most economic resources available.

If you have heard that Northwestern Energy is building more gas plants, that is not true at the time. They do not have a location in Montana to build at this time.

They do not have any ownership in Colstrip Plants number 1 and 2 that are being closed.

Debbie also talked about the street lights project that they are taking on. They are converting the street lights that they own to LED. They are starting first in Billings, then Helena. Keep in mind they do not own all of the street lights.

Some of the street lights are owned by the City and they will not be converting the city—owned lights. If you have questions about your street light district fees assessed to you on your property taxes, you would contact the City not Northwestern Energy. Just don't call me, I get enough calls in a day that have nothing to do with low income housing that I can't help out with..........

If you own a business, there are rebates available, so if you're interested give Debbie a call. Brandin M. who works at CTA also seems very knowledgeable on the rebates for NorthWestern Energy so I'm thinking he could point you in the right direction.

We also learned that when your power goes out, don't call Dan! He doesn't know why your power is out!!

Debbie also spoke for a few minutes on bitcoins. This was entirely over my head and apparently above my intelligence so I didn't even get good notes on it to share with you!
