Announcements

- Rene showed us the Honorable Plank Holder Certificate the Club received from the USS Billings Commissioning Committee folks for our financial support of the commissioning of that ship. As you remember from Commissioner Pitman's presentation a couple of weeks ago, a part of the newly completed and commissioned ship - traditionally a plank as in deck planking - is given to each member of the ship's crew once the ship is launched into operation. The USS Billings commissioning committee from Billings made some really nice engraved "planks" for the crew and presented those to them at the Commissioning Ceremony down in Key West along with some other nice swag and BTW, this swag or care packages are kind of expected to continue coming from the ship's namesake City or State. So this is actually a point of discussion among the Grants Committee group on how best to provide care packages and the like to the crew moving forward.
