Our guests this morning were the beer captains. They just wanted to go over some items they feel need to be addressed when working as well as some things that club members need to work on:

- a. Show up and come sign in at the Southeast Corner. At that point, you will be sent to the area where the beer captains have already scheduled you. During normal concerts you will enter the Metra between the rock wall and the Metra on the east side. During large concerts the Metra may request that we enter in by the bottom of the building, but you will be informed prior to the event.
- b. Wiley says, I say Wiley says that if you are the last to show up during an event, don't ask to leave first!
- c. Make sure if you are working with a newly sponsored member, to let the beer captains know ahead of time so they can schedule you in the same booth.
- d. Stay in the booth that you are assigned unless told by a beer captain. They may show up needing you and if you are not there, it makes the task harder on them.
- e. There are newish 2018 license identification books in all of the booths. If you have a question on any id's check the book.
- f. Remember this is how we raise money. If someone needs to be cut off, don't assume that someone else will do it, if you don't feel they should have any more, then they need to be cut off. No one in the booth with judge you, we are all there to support one another.
- g. Make sure that if you are doing the register, to close out and get escorted to the main booth to count your money. This is requested so that no one gets forgotten about. Always have an escort when carrying money.
- h. There is a sign-up sheet for the registers and there is also a training video for the registers. Remember, we need cashiers, ID and wristbanders and people to pour beer. Share in the duties so that no one person is always stuck doing the same job.
