Montana has approximately 13,000 veterans and Miguel and his gang of 35 or so other volunteers are busy. Some of the things they offer include suicide prevention and PTSD groups, providing backpacks and meals, repairing vehicles, help with finding employment, and the list goes on and on. They will hook veterans and their families up with massage therapy, yoga, reduced rate dental services and free cleanings or even getting a haircut.

The need for this kind of service is continually growing across the state, they are always looking for volunteers and you don't have to be a veteran to join this group.
