Just as a recap for anyone that might not remember or are new members this year, the proceeds from last year's Food Truck Battle went to start up a Veterans Matter Chapter in Montana.

Ken reported that as of this morning, 26 veterans have been housed in Montana because of this program. Of those 26 veterans, there were eight just housed last month. Ken is also going to reach out to the VA in Montana to ask what else can be done to help house homeless veterans. It is not just the veterans that this program helps to house, but their families as well. Montana has housed 26 veterans, many of those vets had families including three families in December that had a home for Christmas.
