Billings about sharing your "G I F T S" and highlighted Elyssa in that talk. The Southside Improvement Task Force hired her to complete the underpass project. She is now taking that one step further and, with permission from the Department of Transportation, she is working toward painting murals in other areas of Billings. She said the murals are painted with an exterior paint and protected by an anti-graffiti silicone based cover. She is in the process of raising funds to complete these projects. She also said that the Billings Police Department has reported that crime as reduced in those areas where she has painted murals. The homeless in the 6th street area said they take pride in it and will protect it.
