- 2. There will be a new parking lot between the Pavilion and Expo Center.
- 3. Gate entry for the fair will be moved closer towards the Pavilion.
- 4. There is a new parking plan in the SE corner where the huge mound of dirt used to be.
- 5. Recently there have been new security cameras installed around the Metra and they are working on installing them all over the grounds as well.
- 6. Venue Solutions Group has been taken on in a management capacity but the county is trying to decide what their duties will be.
- 7. There is a new ticketing system AXS. Tim recommends downloading the app for concerts and other events at the Metra.
- 8. The Metra is working with Verizon on bringing a booster system to the grounds so we won't have the crashing issues that we have during large concerts and sporting events.
- 9. There will be a new POS system coming in May. Unlike the old system, this will be hard wired so hopefully there will not be issues.
- 10. The Metra is working on an outdoor arena for motor cross and rodeo events. Hopefully it will be available in 2024.
