Speaker: Deb Cole, CPS Regional Director

Our speaker today was Deb Cole with CPS. Deb moved here about nine years ago. There are 695 kids currently in their care. They are exiting kids faster than they are taking them in. They have been able to improve their services due to getting more staff. There are currently 15 investigators. She has also been able to increase the pay of the case workers by about \$5 an hour and start offering wellness programs for staff making them better able to cope with the horrible things/trauma they witness.

They receive approximately 300 calls a month on their hot line reporting abuse. Of those, about 115—135 turn into cases that the case workers investigate. Of the 115-135, about 20 need full services.

Drug abuse, physical and sexual abuse are the type of abuse seen. When kids are removed from the home, unification is the goal. They do try and place the kids with other family

members while problems are solved when possible. They currently have three foster home openings.
