As per Shawnees announcement PBR is in April.

The commissioners wanted to let us know about the Outdoor arena and it's schedule. It will hold 3k seats and will be behind the EXPO Center. They are hoping that it will be available for the fair.

The elections office will be moving to the Metra in Cedar Hall. This will be beneficial for parking during the elections.

The open showings of animals before the fair have been canceled. This will not interfere with 4H, but it just doesn't make sense to use the space the way that we have been.

Many may know that the DOT wants to buy land from the Metra to add another lane to HWY 87. This will ease up on the traffic flow, especially during the fair and other Metra events. The county will use those funds for more improvements to the grounds.

The commissioners wanted to stress that the updated camping spots are not to be in competition with the private sector. They are there for use by those individuals and families who are participating in events at the Metra.
