

Welcome to the Breakfast Exchange Club (BEC)

Here are a few tips and responsibilities...

TIPS TRAINING:

Due to Montana State Law, every BEC member must officially take and pass TIPS training – this includes any spouses who plan to assist at events as well. Every new member has a maximum of 60 days in which to complete this training. Failure to do so may result in the termination of your membership.

MEETINGS:

Meetings of the BEC are held every Friday at 7am in the Yellowstone Room. You are encouraged to attend and a portion of your quarterly dues cover the cost of each Friday's breakfast. Please note that the Friday following the second Monday of every month (Board Meeting Night) is designated a "Business Meeting". NO guests at business meetings please.

WORK YOUR SCHEDULED SHIFT:

Our main club income is derived from beer sales at events held in the Metra or Pavilion. Therefore, it is vital all scheduled members show up for their scheduled times.

SCHEDULING: The club President-Elect will email you ahead of each scheduling round to inform you of the upcoming events and dates. It is your responsibility to reply with a list of any dates for which you are unable to work. After adequate time has passed for such replies, a schedule will be emailed to all including each event, the time you are required to show up for the shift, and who the assigned Beer Captain is for that event.

SUBSTITUTIONS: If for any reason, you become unable to work a shift for which you've been assigned, it is your responsibility to find someone to take your place. Simply letting the beer captain know you can't make it is not good enough.

SHIFT PROCEDURES: We enter through the South WEST glass doors which are at the ground level of the arena. Then, proceed up the stairs to the main level and to the far left and back (South EAST) beer booth. Here, there will be the BEC official list of scheduled workers. Sign in on the printed list here and then find your beer captain. He/she will tell you to which sales location to go.

DUES:

Your payment of dues, \$120/quarter, is due in a timely manner. Any member who falls in arrears by two quarters may be subject to termination of their membership.

NO SOLICITATION:

We kindly ask that the BEC email list be used for official club business only and never utilized for solicitation of any type of business or political agendas.

BREAKFAST EXCHANGE CLUB OFFICIAL NEWS:

Otherwise known as the BECON. The BECON is a weekly recap of the events that occurred at each weekly breakfast meeting. Should you be unable to attend a breakfast meeting, this is the best way to keep up on events happening in the club and at the meetings.

SPOUSES WELCOME:

The BEC welcomes and encourages spousal participation. In fact, there is even a new membership option should both of you want to become official members! Inquire with your officers if you are interested. Spouses are welcome at almost all functions and are encouraged to assist with events at Metra once they are properly TIPS trained.
